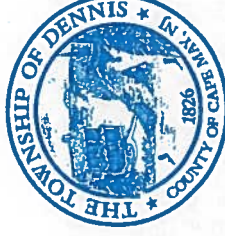

## **RECYCLE ALL ITEMS BELOW IN ONE CONTAINER**

All the recycled items below can now be placed in one container "INSTEAD" of placing bottles/cans and paper in separate containers.

### **PAPER:**

Newspapers  
Office Papers  
Junk Mail  
Magazines  
Shredded Paper (in a clear plastic bag)  
Telephone & Paperback Books  
Cardboard and **CLEAN** Pizza Boxes  
Dry Food Boxes (i.e., Cereal & Cracker Boxes)  
Beer & Soda Carriers  
Wrapping Paper

### **PLASTIC:**

#1 through #7 Plastic Bottles & Containers including:  
Food & Beverage Containers (i.e., Margarine Tubs,  
Microwave Trays, Yogurt Containers)  
Health, Beauty & Cleaning Product Containers  
Other Rigid Plastic Containers including:  
Buckets & Landscape Pots  
(Five (5) gallon size or less)

### **METAL:**

Food, Beverage & Aerosol Cans:  
Aluminum  
Steel (Tin)

### **GLASS:**

Food & Beverage Glass containers including:  
Clear  
Green  
Brown Bottles, Jars & Jugs

Empty and rinse out containers that are to be recycled, remove lids.  
Recycling containers must be labeled.  
Items are not to be placed curbside earlier than the night before collection.  
No recycling containers weighing over **50** pounds will be collected.

### **DO NOT RECYCLE**

Food Contaminated Boxes, Styrofoam Packaging, Polystyrene Egg  
Cartons, Wax-Coated Cardboard Boxes, Window Glass, Beverage Cups,

Paint Cans, PVC Pipes, Light Bulbs, Plastic Bags or any items that  
contained chemical or hazardous products.

## **WEEKLY SCHEDULE - RECYCLING AND TRASH PICK UP**

### **MONDAY**

**AREA 1:** From Johnson's Mill Pond North, including NW Dennis, Eldora,  
and Belleplain.

### **TUESDAY**

**AREA 2:** From Johnson's Mill Pond south, including all of Dennisville and  
part of South Dennis, including all roads branching off Route 47. Route 83  
to and including Dennis Creek Village. Dennisville Road from Route 83 to  
intersection of Hagen Road and Dennisville Road.

### **WEDNESDAY**

**AREA 3: Remainder** of Route 83, Route 9 south from the intersection of  
Route 9 and Route 83, all of Kings Highway to Woodbine-Ocean View  
Road, Dennisville Road from intersection with Hagen Road to intersection  
with Main Street in South Seaville, Hagen Road, North and South  
Ravenwood Drive, and all roads branching off of these roads.

### **THURSDAY**

**AREA 4: Route 9** north of intersection with Route 83, all roads east of  
Route 9, Corson Tavern Road, Woodbine-Ocean View Road, Main Street  
in South Seaville, De Vaul's Lane, Tompkins Lane, Alexandra Way, and all  
roads branching off of these roads.
