

**TOWNSHIP OF DENNIS

The meeting was called to order by the Clerk, Jacqueline B. Justice.

The Clerk announced that notice of this meeting had been published in the Herald and also had been placed on the bulletin board in the Township Hall, pursuant to N.J.S. 10:4-6 et. seq.

The Clerk requested that everyone stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk conducted the roll call with the following Committee Members present: DiCicco, Murphy, Germanio, Teefy and Glembocki.

A competing motion was made by Committeeman Germanio nominating Michael J. Donohue as the Township Solicitor for the year 2012 and the Municipal Clerk indicated that we must address the current motion on the floor and conducted a roll call on the motion nominating Paul J. Baldini for Township Solicitor for the year 2012. DiCicco – Committeeman DiCicco advised the Mayor that Mr. Donohue is highly qualified as well as Mr. Baldini, but that the issue is that Mr. Baldini’s proposal is \$20,000.00 cheaper and that we need to follow Governor Christie’s directive of having lean government and he reiterated that Mike Donohue is a great guy, however being \$20,000.00 cheaper he has to vote yes for Mr. Baldini; Murphy – yes; Germanio – no; Teefy – no and Glembocki – Mayor Glembocki responded to Committeeman DiCicco and indicated that after reviewing all the proposals he believed that Mr. April’s and Mr. Donohue’s proposals were more inclusive and that Mr. Baldini’s proposal was not as inclusive and the Township could incur additional charges and therefore he was voting no. The motion was defeated.

The Municipal Clerk now addressed the motion by Germanio, seconded by Teefy nominating Michael J. Donohue as the Township Solicitor for 2012. Roll call was conducted: DiCicco – no, Murphy – no, Germanio – yes, Teefy – yes and Glembocki – yes.

The Mayor asked for a motion establishing the Temporary Budget for the year 2012.

Motion was made by DiCicco, seconded by Germanio, with 5 ayes and no nays, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-13

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE 2012 TEMPORARY BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-19 provides that the Governing Body shall make temporary appropriations to provide for the period between the beginning of the budget year and the date of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the date of this resolution is prior to January 30 of the 2012 budget year; and

WHEREAS, the total of the temporary appropriations do not exceed 26.25% of the total of all budget appropriations of the preceding year, less appropriations for debt service, capital improvement fund, and public assistance, and which amount is \$1,177,381.57.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the temporary appropriations in the amount of \$1,100,000.00 be made and that a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Chief Financial Officer.

The Mayor then asked for comments from the Committee.

Committeeman DiCicco welcomed everyone and thanked them for coming out. He congratulated Mayor Glembocki, Deputy Mayor Teefy and Mr. Germanio and welcomed them to the Committee and indicated he looks forward to working with them. Committeeman DiCicco commented on the issues facing the Township Committee in 2012 and stated that the interesting thing with politics is the politician do not get to pick the team, that the tax payers pick the team and this is the team and we need to work together to solve these issues. He commented on the lingering issue of ATV's and commented on an article in the Atlantic City Press regarding a School Board Member in South Jersey that is going to be censored by the Department of Education for calling local employees terrorist. Committeeman DiCicco indicated that the reason he brings this up is because the rhetoric regarding the ATV issue has gotten so bad that with residents calling residents terrorist, relating ATV use to ground-zero. He stated he believes calling ATV users terrorist is over the top and he indicated that terrorist is usually associated with events such as: Lockerbie, Okalahoma City and the Beirut Marine Barracks and that the term ground-zero is used when there are mass deaths such as Hiroshima, Nagasaki and the World Trade Center. He indicated to connect ATV use with events like these is way over the top and disrespectful to the true victims of terrorism. Committeeman DiCicco called upon the residents to lower the rhetoric and have rational, common sense discussion. He stated that this situation needs peace makers and problem solvers and he hopes that with two new Committee Members and a new Solicitor we will get some good insight. He congratulated the three new guys again, thanked everyone and asked God's blessings.

Committeeman Murphy joked that he was still looking up all the big words Committeeman DiCicco used. He congratulated the new Committee Members and Solicitor. He indicated that this is the team and everything will work out fine and that everyone is here for the same reason, for the people of Dennis Township. He wished everyone a Happy New Year and thanked the Congressman for coming.

Committeeman Germanio congratulated Mayor Glembocki and Deputy Mayor Teefy. He indicated that he looks forward to working with the entire Committee. He thanked everyone for coming out this evening and promised to do the best he can for all residents of Dennis Township. Committeeman Germanio thanked everyone for giving him this opportunity and his family, friends and neighbors for their support. He thanked Congressman LoBiondo for administering the oath of office and wished everyone a Happy New Year.

Deputy Mayor Teefy congratulated Committeeman Germanio and Mayor Glembocki. He this is the team and that they will work together. He thanked everyone for coming tonight and Congressman LoBiondo and the other officials. Deputy Mayor Teefy stated that they are here to do the best they can for the residents of Dennis Township. He wished everyone a Happy New Year and indicated that he looks forward to keeping a crowd at the meetings.

Mayor Glembocki thanked everyone for coming, his fellow Committee Members and for the nominations this evening. He indicated that we have a good team here and he agrees with Committeeman DiCicco 100% regarding the ATV issue, and that he believes that this Committee can move forward with this issue and get results. He agreed that the situation needs to be calmed down and he indicated that the new Solicitor, Mike Donohue, lives in one of the areas of concern. Mayor Glembocki acknowledged dignitaries in the audience: former Mayors – John Champion, Bob Grace, Harry Creamer; Congressman Frank LoBiondo; County Clerk Rita Fulginiti; Freeholders – Gerald Thornton & Susan Sheppard; Freeholders Elect Kristine Gabor & Will Morey; Sheriff Cary Schaffer; Executive Undersheriff John Maher; Undersheriff Bob Nolan; local Mayors Suzanne Walters & Marty Pagliughi; State Committeewoman Linda Pagliughi; Committeeman Dan Lockwood; Committeeman Elect Tim Donohue; former Upper Township Committeeman Frank Conrad; former Dennis Township Committeeman & Co-leader of the local Republican Committee Ed Beck; and County Prosecutor Bob Taylor. Mayor Glembocki indicated they will do their best for Dennis Township and that he looks forward to serving this community. Mayor Glembocki questioned the need for a Resolution re-appointing our Tax Collector and the Clerk advised him that it can be done at the next Township Committee meeting with a retroactive date and the Solicitor concurred.

Motion was made by Murphy, seconded by Germanio, that the meeting be open for public comment.

Dr. Gerry Martin commented as the oldest member of the Glembocki Family, she congratulated the Committee for their exquisite choice in naming their beloved nephew/son as Mayor. She indicated that the United States of America should follow the leadership of the Township of Dennis in the next election.

There being no further comment from those present, motion was made by Murphy, seconded by Teefy, that the public comment portion be closed.

The Benediction was given by Pastor John Warren.

Mayor Glembocki invited everyone out to the Belleplain V.F.W. for a social time to meet the Committee and have refreshments.
