7:00 P.M. TWP. COMMITTEE REGULAR MEETING

Mayor Glembocki opened the meeting in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act requirements.

Mayor Glembocki asked that the flag salute, moment of silence and reading of the names of the lost soldiers be carried over from the Work Session meeting.

Mayor Glembocki presided with Committee Members: DiCicco, Murphy, and Teefy present, Committeeman Germanio was absent.

Motion was made by Teefy, seconded by Murphy, with 4 ayes and 1 absent (Germanio), that the following minutes be approved:

Motion was made by Teefy, seconded by DiCicco, with 4 ayes and 1 absent (Germanio), that the following Officer's Report were approved:

Motion was made by Murphy, seconded by Teefy, that the meeting be open for public comment. All in favor and the motion carried.

John Turner of Ocean View questioned the status of the Master Plan.

Mayor Glembocki and Township Engineer, Jack Gibson, gave an update on the Master Plan revisions and costs associated with it.

Deputy Mayor Teefy commented on contacting the Finance Officer and Auditor for their recommendations regarding the costs.

Committeeman DiCicco clarified with the Engineer that if we do nothing we will lose the opportunity for the Centers.

The Engineer commented on certification.

Walt Noll of 164 Gravel Hole Road questioned the status of the letter that is to be sent to the Planning Board regarding their portion of the ATV ordinance issue.

Township Solicitor, Mike Donohue, explained and indicated that the letter will be going out to the Planning Board shortly.

Mr. Noll asked for an update of the Beaver Dam Road drainage project.

The Engineer commented on the Beaver Dam Road drainage project and his discussions with the County on a possible joint effort to do a positive outfall project.

Mr. Noll continued regarding the Beaver Dam Road drainage project, whether the issue is a County problem and the bond ordinance that was adopted to finance said project.

The Engineer made additional comments regarding the Beaver Dam Road drainage project and the Committee requested that he contact Dale Foster, the County Engineer, to get their status report.

Mike Fossett of Hagen Road indicated that he has been listening to the Zoning Board meetings online and questioned variances applicants are requesting.

Mayor Glembocki commented and indicated that they comply.

Mr. Fossett questioned the status of the Budget.

Mayor Glembocki indicated that it was nail biting and Deputy Mayor Teefy indicated that they would be meeting with the Auditor in the next couple weeks to start next years budget.

Mr. Fossett questioned how much Maser had been paid this year.

Mayor Glembocki and Deputy Mayor Teefy indicated that they did not know the exact amount, however most of what they have been paid is for Planning Board which is off-set by escrows. Deputy Mayor Teefy indicated that he would get a report from the Finance Officer and forward it to Mr. Fossett.

Committeeman DiCicco, Deputy Mayor Teefy discussed the escrow accounts.

Gary Gibson of 158 Gravel Hole Road commented on the ATV issue such as ATV's being ridden on the Barry property, vandalism, the ATV Sub-Committee, and Township ordinance vs. Buena Vista's ordinance. Mr. Gibson also commented on a noise ordinance. Mr. Gibson submitted a copy of an nuisance/noise ordinance that Mr. April had drafted to the Clerk. Mr. Gibson continued regarding previous noise ordinances that were drafted and/or tabled. Mr. Gibson commented on ATVer's rights and his rights.

Committeeman DiCicco questioned the dates and times that the ATV riding resumed. Mr. Gibson indicated that he would email the info to him.

Mr. Gibson commented on the ATV damage at the Rec Park and ATV riding down Hagen Road last Halloween as well as other roads. He urged the Committee to request additional patrols from the State Police. Mayor Glembocki indicated that he would.

There being no further comments from those present, motion was made by Murphy, seconded by Teefy, that the public comment portion be closed. The motion carried.

The Clerk asked the Mayor if they were tabling the motion to authorize the Mayor to sign the Measure Acceptance Form and initial the block of page two of said form for the Public Works Direct Install Energy Program. The Solicitor explained the need for clarification and Committeeman DiCicco indicated that he would contact Mr. Rutala.

Let the record reflect that Resolution Nos. 2012-118 thru 2012-119 were part of a consent agenda with a block motion and roll call.
