
RE: Emergency Waiver

Dear Mayor Glembocki:

Please be advised that the above Board met on this date at 7:00 p.m. to discuss the Township Committee's request for an Emergency Waiver to allow mosquito spraying to be done at the Recreation Center located at 565 Dennisville Road, South Dennis, NJ.

The Advisory Board understands the Committee's concern for the public's health and welfare while the Summer Basketball Program and Summer Camp Program are going on. We have reviewed information on the West Nile Virus and echo the Committee's concerns for the public's health and welfare and to that end have no objections to the Committee's request for the Emergency Waiver. However, the Advisory Board has looked into possible ways to biologically control the mosquitoes, and although we have no objections to the Emergency Waiver, we would formally request that the Township forward a letter to the Cape May County Department of Mosquito Control to petition them to stock the pond located on the County property which adjoins the Recreation Park (formally known as the Kapp Gravel Pit) with *Gambusia affinis*. This fish is a mosquito eating fish that help to suppress the populations.

## Chapter 78 CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS

### ARTICLE I

#### Solicitation of Motorists; Coin-Drops

§ 78-1. Solicitation permitted.

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis 6-23-97 by Ord. No. 97-10. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 78-1. Solicitation permitted.

- A. The following nonprofit charitable organizations are hereby permitted to solicit contributions along the roadways in the Township of Dennis pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 39:4-60: Belleplain Emergency Corp., Belleplain Volunteer Fire Company, Dennis Township Rescue Squad, Dennis Township Volunteer Fire Company, and Ocean View Volunteer Fire Company.
- B. If collections are to occur along a county or state highway, permission must be obtained from the necessary authority as provided in R.S. 39:4-60 as amended.
- C. A certified copy of this section shall be provided to each individual agency, to the Board of Chosen Freeholders, and the New Jersey Commissioner of Transportation.
- D. This section will take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with the law.

**Re: Dennis Township Revaluation Program for the 2015 Tax Year**

Dear Ms. Sutton:

We are in receipt of your request concerning the above-captioned matter, based on your preliminary Bid Specifications, for the 2014 tax year.

I have spoken to Mr. G. Raymond Brown, Cape May County Tax Administrator, regarding the proposed timeline for your revaluation. All parties are aware that there must be sufficient time provided for the revaluation to be completed in a professional, competent manner. Due to the length of the process to award the contract, obtain state approval of same, as well as obtaining state approval of the municipal tax maps, Mr. Brown is willing to allow the Township to bring in the revaluation for the 2015 tax year. Mr. Brown is willing to do this, provided the Township proceeds in a timely manner, and that the revaluation commences this year, 2013, within thirty (30) days of state contract approval.

Regarding the specifications, VITAL has the following exceptions/suggestions, upon which our proposal is based:

VITAL would except to Paragraph 3.4.8, Page 6, which requires renting/leasing office space. It would not be economically feasible to rent an office with sufficient space for informal taxpayer hearings, as well as parking for same. Our experience indicates that property owners are more comfortable in a public setting such as municipal courtroom, community center, etc. We would hope the Township could provide such space for the informal hearings. The revaluation would be run from our Pleasantville, New Jersey office.

Vital would suggest that Paragraph 4.16.1 should be changed to reflect a two (2) year appeal defense, which is in conformance with the Base Revaluation Specifications promulgated by the State of New Jersey Division of Taxation.

VITAL would except to the timeline, as stated on Page 23, which is not in conformance with Base Revaluation Specifications as promulgated by the State of New Jersey Division of Taxation. I would be glad to meet with you to establish the timeline, as well as a corresponding Plan of Work.

VITAL would except to Paragraph 7.2.2, Page 28, which requires a minimum standard of eighty (80%) interior inspection rate. Interior inspection requirements depend on compliance by property owners to allow access to the interior of their properties, which is not mandatory under state law. There is no way to compel voluntary compliance to contact our office to arrange an interior inspection. VITAL, and any other revaluation vendor, cannot guarantee a specific internal inspection rate, in our opinion, in good faith. VITAL will, however, meet all requirements under regulations promulgated by the Division of Taxation regarding property inspection procedures.

VITAL would except to Paragraph 10.5.1 through Paragraph 10.5.6, starting on Page 31, regarding digital photographs. VITAL proposes to furnish one (1) front/side view digital photograph of each improved property. The photographs will be integrated with your VITAL CAMA via VITALImaging, which is included in our proposal.



A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF A MINING AND EXCAVATION PERMIT RENEWAL FOR BLOCK 120, LOTS 63-67, 74, 75 AND 79.

WHEREAS, Hanson Aggregates- BMC, is the owner of property known as Block 120, Lots 63-67, 74, 75 and 79 in South Dennis, Dennis Township, New Jersey, on which property it operates a sand mining and excavation operation; and

WHEREAS, Hanson Aggregates – BMC currently holds a mining and excavation permit for this site, initially issued in 1996, and renewed in 2001, 2003, 2007 and 2010; and

WHEREAS, Hanson Aggregates – BMC now seeks renewal of that permit for a three-year period, installation of additional perimeter fencing and waiver from having a 24 hour security guard; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Township's excavation ordinance, Hanson Aggregates- BMC's application for that renewal was referred to the Dennis Township Consolidated Land Use Board for a hearing on site plan details and recommendation to the Township Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Land Use Board has held such a hearing, including a public hearing, on the application at its regular meeting of February 28, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the applicant, represented by Rocco J. Tedesco, Esquire, appeared at that meeting and presented testimony from the following persons: Lance Landgraf, a licensed planner with Marathon Engineering & Environmental Services of Hammonton, New Jersey, to any questions from the Board or the public; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant in addition to the Exhibits of the Application introduced into evidence the following exhibits at the hearing:

A-1 Cape Concrete 2012 Permit Renewal Plans by Marathon Engineering & Environmental Services, Inc., dated February 13, 2013 (8 pages).

A2-3 Cape Con Resource Extraction Plans by Marathon Engineering & Environmental Services, Inc., dated February 28, 2013 detailing the existing signage and aerial photograph.

WHEREAS no member of the public spoke in favor or against the application at the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Dennis Township Consolidated Land Use Board having carefully considered the evidence presented by the applicant, the plans, the application, the exhibits, and the testimony of the witnesses, and having considered as well the comments of its engineer and solicitor, has made and hereby memorializes the following findings of fact and/or conclusions of law:

1. The applicant has standing to present this application by virtue of its status as owner of the subject property,
2. The board has jurisdiction to hear this application with the majority vote of the qualified board members required to recommend action on the application.
3. The application is deemed complete for purposes of the township land use and resource extraction laws.
4. Applicant has given all notices required under law.
5. The board accepts as factual and incorporates the report of its engineer John C. Gibson, dated February 21, 2013 including its findings and recommendations.

6. Other than as directly addressed within this Resolution, all previous Resolutions and conditions shall continue in full force as adopted.

7. There is currently little activity on site, but applicant seeks to keep its right to use the land in place.

8. The application complies in all other respects with the Dennis Township land use and excavation ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Dennis Township Consolidated Land Use Board on March 28, 2013 that:

1. Applicant's continued request for a waiver of the requirement that internal roads at the site be paved and curbed is granted.

2. Applicant's request for a Waiver of the requirement of a 24 hour guard is hereby granted on the conditions:

a. The Applicant maintains the 24 guard until all fencing is completely installed pursuant to the Applicant's plan as approved at the hearing;

b. The Applicant provides and the Board Engineer approves a detailed inspection plan to assure the fence remains in good condition and performs its purpose.

c. The Applicant shall install a chain link fence to be located 1 to 2 feet inside the edge of the pond along the northwest side. Once the fence extends from the pond, the fence shall follow the limits of Mining Area 1 and shall be extended as each mining area becomes active such that all existing ponds and active mining areas are enclosed by a 6 foot chain link fence.

3. Applicants request for preliminary and final site plan is approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Consolidated Land Use Board that the following recommendations be made to the Township Committee:

1. Based on applicant's satisfaction of the conditions of Resolution 2010-06 and on Applicant's further presentation to the Consolidated Land Use Board, and subject to the conditions set forth below, Applicant's request for a renewal of the mining and excavation permit, for a period of three years, should be approved.

2. The recommendation for approval is subject to the following conditions;

A. The conditions contained in the report of the Board's engineer, John C. Gibson, dated February 21, 2013, including the recommendations.

B. Applicant shall continue to comply with all Conditions of the previous Resolutions unless specifically addressed in this Resolution.

C. Applicant shall receive all other federal, state and local governmental approvals for the continued operation of the mining and extraction facility.

D. Applicant shall provide all sloping stabilization as noted on the site plan during the continuing operation of the site based upon site inspections performed by and recommendations made by the Township Engineer.

E. The Applicant shall maintain the 24 guard until all fencing is completely installed to cover the existing ponds and active mining sites;

F. The Applicant shall provide and the Board Engineer approves a detailed inspection plan to assure the fence remains in good condition and performs its purpose.

This Resolution is adopted in full memorialization of the recommendation made by the Dennis Township Consolidated Land Use Board at its February 28, 2013 meeting.
