4:00 P.M. TWP. COMMITTEE REGULAR MEETING

Mayor Glembocki opened the meeting in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act requirements.

Mayor Glembocki requested that the roll call be carried over from the Board of Health Meeting which reflected DiCicco, Murphy, Germanio, Teefy and Glembocki present.

Mayor Glembocki asked that everyone please stand for the flag salute, moment of silence and reading of the names of the lost soldiers.

Committeeman DiCicco read the names of the fallen soldiers.

The Mayor indicated that up for discussion is the membership renewal in the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund. There being no questions or comments regarding this issue the Mayor instructed the Clerk to place a resolution on the next agenda.

Mayor Glembocki indicated that the Committee would now discuss the 2012 Audit. There being no questions regarding the Audit the Clerk indicated that a resolution would be placed on the next agenda.

Mayor Glembocki indicated that the Committee would now have the public comment period on our Agenda items and anyone wishing to address the Committee on the Agenda items may do so at this time by coming forward and stating their name and address for the record.

Mike Fossett of Hagen Road questioned what the public comment portion was for and was advised that it is for agenda items and that there would be a separate public comment portion for general comments.

There being no comment from the public on agenda items, Mayor Glembocki questioned the Committee if they had any questions or concerns with the consent agenda.

There being no comment from the Committee regarding the consent agenda, Mayor Glembocki asked for a motion approving the consent agenda, motion was made by Murphy, seconded by Teefy, with 5 ayes and no nays, that the consent agenda be adopted.

March 19, 2013 (Regular Meeting) minutes were apart of the consent agenda and hereby approved.

Bob Grace of 659 Petersburg Road in Dennisville offered Committeeman Germanio his condolences on the loss of his father and asked what the Ordinance means. Mr. Grace expressed concern over people standing in the road. The Committee explained that the amendment is to allow the Recreation Associations to solicit as well as the fire companies. There being no further comment from those present, motion was made by Teefy, seconded by Germanio, that the Hearing be closed.

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-97

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A MEETING NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW JERSEY OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis is subject to certain requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12 b and designated below:

Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting. Possible hiring, terms & status – Municipal Clerk’s Office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, assembled in public session on June 17, 2013, that an Executive Session closed to the public shall be held on June 17, 2013 prior to the close of the above night’s meeting in the Dennis Township Municipal Complex, 571 Petersburg Road, Dennisville, New Jersey, for the discussion of matters relating to the specific items designed above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is anticipated that the deliberations conducted in closed session may be disclosed to the public upon the determination of the Township Committee that the public interest will no longer be served by such confidentiality.

Motion was made by Murphy, seconded by Teefy, 5 ayes and no nays and the motion carried, that the following Administrative Reports were adopted:

Tax Collector's Report May, 2013

At this time the Mayor made the following Mayoral Appointments –

The Mayor indicated that we will now have the second public comment period. Anyone wishing to address Township Committee may do so at this time by coming forward to the microphone and stating your name and address for the record. He asked if you have commented earlier in the meeting, please limit your comments to items not previously discussed.

Mike Fossett of Hagen Road expressed his condolences to Committeeman Germanio for the lost of his father and indicated that he had lost his mother & father in February. Mr. Fossett questioned the status of the Zoning Ordinance to implement the Master Plan and the Clerk advised that it will have a Public Hearing on July 2nd. He indicated that he has lived here for 27 years and that he moved here because of the zoning. Mr. Fossett commented on the condition of the Township and questioned if something can be done regarding bulk items sometimes whole contents of a home, being placed at the curb early and setting out there for 5 weeks. He recommended sending a letter out to let residents know when their bulk day is. Mr. Fossett also commented on brush & leaves that are still out.

Mayor Glembocki indicated that he believed that the brush and leaves were picked up, but that he would contact the Assistant Supervisor of Public Works.

Mr. Fossett continued regarding his concerns and political issues.

Committeeman Germanio commented regarding who runs the Township and the Committee commented on brush & leaves still being out.

Bob Grace of 659 Petersburg Road commented on Animal Control concerns regarding wildlife. Mr. Grace questioned if the County had responded to the traffic concerns on Petersburg Road.

Deputy Mayor Teefy indicated that he had spoken to Freeholder Desiderio and County Engineer, Dale Foster, and they indicated that they would do a traffic investigation.

Mr. Grace commented on his concerns regarding the speeding trucks and Mayor Glembocki questioned the Clerk on who enforces the official truck routes. The Clerk indicated that it would be the M.U.A.

Mr. Grace commented on trucks using Petersburg Road as well as Mrs. Michele Heim.

The discussion regarding trucks using Petersburg Road continued. Mr. Grace urged the Committee to keep on the County regarding a solution.

Committeeman DiCicco advised Mr. Grace that Jack Connolly has had success with contacting the truck companies and he indicated that if anyone witnesses the speeding and gives him a call with the company he will contact the company.

There being no further comment from those present, the Mayor asked for comments from the Committee.

Committeeman Murphy indicated that he had no comment at this time.

Committeeman DiCicco extended his condolences to the Germanio family on the lost of Frank Germanio, Sr. He shared that after church out at St. Casimir's on Sunday a gentleman indicated that Frank Sr. was the nicest man in Cape May County. Committeeman DiCicco indicated how impressive a comment like that is and what a legacy Frank Sr. imparted

Committeeman Germanio thanked everyone for their support regarding the lost of his father.

Deputy Mayor Teefy indicated that he had no comment at this time.

Mayor Glembocki expressed his condolences to Committeeman Germanio on the loss of his father.

Mayor Glembocki indicated that the Township Committee would take a three (3) minute recess prior to the Executive Session. Motion was made by Murphy, seconded by Teefy and the motion carried.

Motion was made by Murphy, seconded by DiCicco that the Executive Session be closed and the regular meeting reconvened.

Committeeman DiCicco questioned when a resignation becomes public and Mr. Blaney indicated when they tender their resignation.

Mayor Glembocki asked for a motion to authorize the Clerk to advertise for a Temporary Seasonal Keyboarding Clerk. Motion was made by Murphy, seconded by Teefy with all in favor.

Motion was made by Teefy, seconded by Germanio, that the meeting be adjourned. The motion carried.
