Mayor Murphy asked for any public comment on agenda items. Hearing no public comment Mayor Murphy asked for a motion adopting the consent agenda, motion was made by DiCicco, seconded by O'Connor, with 5 ayes and no nays that the consent agenda be adopted.

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-04

**ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION
LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S. 40A:4-45.14)**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 0.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis in the County of Cape May finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2014 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that a 3.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$87,704.18 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis, in the County of Cape May, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2014 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Dennis shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$105,245.02, and that the CY 2014 municipal budget for the Township of Dennis be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within five days of introduction; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within five days after such adoption.

Committeeman DiCicco indicated that there is one vacancy remaining on the Environmental Commission and that they are looking at two candidates.

Motion made by O'Connor, seconded by DiCicco to open the public portion of the meeting. All in favor.

Tom Rock of Ocean View commented on the lack of snow plowing on his street during the various snow storms. Mayor Murphy commented on the lists Public Works goes by and what are primary streets and secondary streets with additional comments from Committeeman Teefy and they indicated that they will look into it. Mr. Rock distributed information to the Committee and commented on Fire District #1's budget and areas where money could be saved. Mr. Rock commented on the current fire Commissioners and indicated he is happy with them. He reiterated his concerns regarding the costs associated with running the fire company. Mr. Rock read an excerpt from minutes of a Fire District #1 meeting regarding firemen infractions, contract negotiations, etc. Mr. Rock commented on the infractions and the fire company's budget in particular their expenses and receipts.

Committeeman DiCicco indicated that we were moving towards the direction of having the fire companies, recreation associations, etc. audited by the Township Auditor.

Mr. Rock continued regarding the firemen infractions.

Hearing no additional public comment, motion made by O'Connor, seconded by Germanio to close the public portion of the meeting.

The Mayor asked for comments from the Committee.

Committeeman Germanio commented on Dennis Township Schools participation in the American Heart Association and Leukemia & Lymphoma Society

Committeeman Teefy indicated that Public Works is currently picking up leaves. He commented on an All Star Game in Ocean City where two Dennis Township girls, Holly McKaig and Alexis Olson made the team and got to play.

Committeeman DiCicco commented on the Museum's Project with interviewing the veterans.

Deputy Mayor O'Connor commented on the School's Meatball Madness and indicated that Mr. Covarrubias was the winner. He also commented on the Spelling Bee where he was a judge with a big cheat-sheet. He stated that it was a nice event put together by the Pride Committee who did a super job. Deputy Mayor O'Connor commented on the Easter Egg Hunt scheduled for April 13th at 11:00 a.m. over at the Recreation Complex rain or shine. He also commented on the Summer Camp Program as well as the bids that were received for Recreation Improvements. He commented on coordinating a night to honor kids that are doing good.

Committeeman DiCicco questioned the Engineer whether the outside basketball project will be completed in time for the Summer Basketball League. Mr. Gibson indicated that it should be completed by early June.

Carol Donovan from Ocean View questioned the Recreation Summer Camp sign-up process and Deputy Mayor O'Connor and Committeeman DiCicco commented on the challenges of the sign-up process.

Ms. Donovan questioned the outcome of the sale of the liquor license last year and the Committee indicated that it was not sold.

Mayor Murphy thanked everyone for coming out this evening.

Mayor Murphy indicated that the Township Committee would take a five (5) minute recess prior to the Executive Session. Motion was made by O'Connor, seconded by DiCicco and the motion carried.

Motion was made by O'Connor, seconded by Teefy, that the Executive Session be closed and the regular meeting be reconvened. All in favor and the motion carried.

Township Solicitor indicated that the record should reflect that in Executive Session the Committee discussed the UFCW decertification, the Soccer Association matter and the Shared Services Agreement with Upper Township Municipal Court Services. He stated that the Clerk will be advising him of the next Upper Township Meeting which he may attend as well as the Clerk reminding the Mayor to contact his counterpart in Upper. He indicated that no formal action was taken.

Committeeman Germanio advised the Committee that he has contacted Fred DeAndrea of Comcast to set up a meeting and has not heard back.
