FROM THE WOODBINE BOROUGH LINE, AT THE EASTERLY TERMINUS OF  
THEIR MULTI USE PATH ALONG DEHIRSCH AVEUNE TO KINGS HIGHWAY  
(COUNTY ROUTE 608)**
