I HAVE PREPARED AND FILED AN APPLICATION FOR A DOT GRANT FOR CONSTRUCTING A BIKEWAY ALONG THE WOODBINE –OCEAN VIEW ROAD. THIS IS THE FIRST PHASE OF A PROPOSED REGIONAL BIKEWAY FROM WOODBINE TO THE COUNTY ZOO.
