ORDINANCE NO. 2018-05

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DENNIS, COUNTY OF CAPE MAY, AND
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 72, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 26
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DENNIS ENTITLED
“BUSINESS LICENSES, PEDDLER’S, HAWKER’S AND VENDOR’S LICENSES”**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Governing Body to protect the citizens and children by requiring vendors to undergo background checks.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 72, Article IV, Section 72-26, entitled Application for License, of the Code of the Township of Dennis is hereby amended and supplemented to add the following subsection to that section:

K. The township requires that all prospective peddlers, hawkers and vendors submit to criminal record history background checks through the State Bureau of Investigation.

1. All such prospective peddlers, hawkers and vendors shall complete and execute a "Request for Criminal History Record Information" form SBI-19 or SBI-19A (for a criminal record history background check by fingerprint analysis), form SBI-212 or SBI-212A (for a criminal record background check by name search), or any other form prescribed by the State Bureau of Investigation as requested by the Clerk and/or Administrator of the Township of Dennis, or his designee. The applicant shall complete these forms in their entirety and shall provide all the information required to complete the check, including the name of the subject, the date of birth of the subject, the social security number of the subject, and where required, an impression of the subject's fingerprints. Pursuant to the Privacy Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-579), the furnishing of social security numbers is voluntary, and the employee's social security number may only be used for purposes of processing requests for criminal history record information.

2. The Clerk and/or Administrator and the Township Solicitor of the Township of Dennis shall be responsible for implementation and administration of the provisions of this Article,

provided, however, that the responsibilities contained herein may be delegated in whole or in part to one (1) or more subordinate officers.

3. The applicant shall bear any costs associated with conducting criminal record history background check.

SECTION 2. This amendment shall take effect immediately after passage and publication according to law.
