

**TOWNSHIP OF DENNIS, NEW JERSEY**

**ORDINANCE 2019-11**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$264,000 TO  
BE USED FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A BIKE PATH FOR  
THE DENNIS TOWNSHIP PORTION OF A COUNTYWIDE  
REGIONAL BIKEWAY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF DENNIS,  
COUNTY OF CAPE MAY, NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body desires to appropriate additional funds for the installation of the Dennis Township Portion of a Countywide Regional Bikeway, originally authorized in Bond Ordinance 2018-04; and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds are available for said purpose from the Cape May County Open Space and Farmland Preservation Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey, that:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the following sources the sum of \$264,000.00 to be used for the following capital projects within the Township of Dennis:

<u>Purpose/Improvement</u>	<u>Estimated Total Cost</u>	<u>County Grant</u>
A. Installation of a bike path for the Dennis Township Portion of a Countywide Regional Bikeway, pursuant to a shared services agreement including, but not limited to, tree removal and pruning excavation, grading, drainage and paving.	\$264,000	\$264,000

**Section 2.** In connection with the amounts authorized in Section 1, the Township makes the following determinations:

- (a) The purpose described in Section 1 is not a Current Expense and is an improvement, which the Township may lawfully make as a general improvement.
- (b) The period of usefulness of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof is twenty (20) years or more.
- (c) No debt is authorized by this ordinance.

- (d) The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk and available for inspection

**Section 3.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the proper passage, publication in accordance with law and after final adoption as provided by law.
