1 AN ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION urging counties and municipalities to
2 create 2020 Census Complete Count Committees.

4 WHEREAS, This year, the federal government, through the United
5 States Census Bureau, will count everyone residing in the United
6 States through a process known as the Census, which occurs at the
7 beginning of each decade; and

8 WHEREAS, The United States Census Bureau must submit state
9 population totals to the President of the United States by December
10 31, 2020; and

11 WHEREAS, It is imperative for the State of New Jersey that the count
12 of our residents be as thorough and complete as possible, as the
13 State's legislative districts and congressional districts will be
14 redrawn, through a process known as redistricting, using the Census
15 data collected in New Jersey by Census workers, and to ensure the
16 State's residents of equal representation in the New Jersey
17 Legislature and in Congress; and

18 WHEREAS, These legislative and congressional districts will remain in
19 place until the 2030 Census and will affect all legislative and
20 congressional elections for the next decade, making it critical that
21 every New Jersey resident be counted in the 2020 Census; and

22 WHEREAS, The federal government also uses census data to designate
23 funds for public services in New Jersey, such as Medicaid, hospital
24 funding, Title I school funding, childcare, student loans, highway
25 and transportation funding, and school meal programs; and

26 WHEREAS, The United States Census Bureau has created a program to
27 develop "Complete Count Committees," the purpose of which is to
28 use county and municipal officials, together with community and
29 faith-based organizations and other community influencers, to reach
30 individuals and families to explain the importance of all local
31 residents taking part in the 2020 Census; and

32 WHEREAS, The United States Census Bureau believes that local
33 Complete Count Committees will further the goal of counting every
34 United States resident in the place where they live, through
35 establishing an "information highway" of neighbor informing
36 neighbor of the importance of participation in the 2020 Census,
37 helping to maximize participation and response rates by State
38 residents by increasing and maintaining public awareness
39 throughout the 2020 census, leading to an accurate 2020 Census

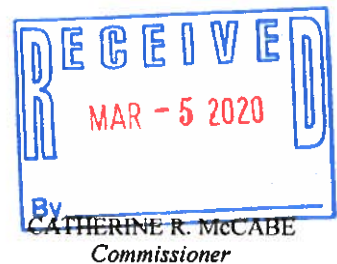

Dear Municipal Clerk,

Amendments to the Stormwater Management rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8, which were proposed by the Department in the December 3, 2018 New Jersey Register at 50 N.J.R. 2375(a) (see https://www.nj.gov/dep/rules/notices_archive.html), were adopted today, March 2, 2020, with non-substantial changes (see <https://www.nj.gov/dep/rules/adoptions.html>).

In accordance with your New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit, the Department is hereby providing all MS4 permittees with **written notification** that their stormwater program, must be revised to conform with these amended rules **within 12 months of this notice**. Specifically, your municipality's Stormwater Control Ordinance (SCO) needs to be revised to conform with these amendments by March 3, 2021.

The Department has revised the model SCO to reflect these rule amendments for the portion of your municipality's land area that is not located within the State-designated Pinelands Area. A copy of this model SCO may be obtained at https://www.njstormwater.org/bmp_manual2.htm. Please note, this sample ordinance is being provided for information purposes only to assist municipalities in the development of municipal stormwater control ordinances consistent with the rules as adopted on March 2, 2020. It is important that the amended rules are carefully reviewed before any portion of this model ordinance is adopted.

For the portion of your municipality's land area that is located within the State-designated Pinelands Area, please wait to revise the SCO applicable in those areas until notified by the Department or the New Jersey Pinelands Commission of a revised model SCO reflecting these rule amendments for Pinelands Area municipalities.

Crosswalks Conditions
Permit #: CW-83-S-21749-2019

1. The allowable work hours under this permit are 9:00 am – 3:30 pm. The permittee shall not interfere with the normal flow of traffic, reduce the number of traffic lanes, or change any traffic pattern at any other time on weekdays and all day on Saturday, Sunday and holidays; unless specifically approved by the Permits office.
2. The local police department should be notified by the permittee before starting any construction that may interfere with traffic.
3. Material cannot be stored nor equipment parked within the State's Right of Way, except as necessary during actual working operations.
4. Lane widths and traffic control devices shall be in conformance with the traffic control plan.
5. The permittee is responsible for installing and maintaining approved construction warning signs. All signs and other protective devices, unless otherwise directed, shall comply with the requirements of the current edition of the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways*, issued by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).
6. Competent uniformed traffic directors shall be employed at every location where the contractor's equipment is working immediately adjacent to, or is entering, leaving or crossing active traffic lanes. The traffic directors shall be employed continuously for the full time such conditions exist.
7. In the event of severe weather or exigent circumstance, the Department shall require the permittee to take whatever steps necessary to secure the traveled way for emergency operations. All work on the roadway shall stop and be cleared of all equipment and material. The area shall be secured to allow safe passage as to not interfere with Department emergency operations.
8. All employees and/or supervisors engaged in a work operation that exposes them to the motoring public, or to a hazardous road condition, or whenever an employee or supervisor is within the State Right of Way (shoulder, etc.) or within a coned-in area, will wear the proper safety apparel, which includes a safety vest.
9. No lane closures will be permitted on the following holidays:
Easter Sunday (including 6:00 am Saturday until noon Monday)
Memorial Day (see note below)
July 4th (see note below)
Labor Day (see note below)
Election Day (6:00 am until 8:00 pm)
Thanksgiving Day (see note below)
Christmas Day (see note below)
New Year's Day (see note below)

The permittee shall defend, indemnify, protect and save harmless the State and its agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all suits, claims, losses, demands, or damages of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of, any negligent act, error or omission of the permittee, its agents, servants, and employees in the performance of the work covered by this permit.

PROTECTION OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC

The permittee shall properly safeguard all work performed under permit and when necessary, maintain sufficient warning lights, department approved signs and safety devices for the protection of the general public until the project has been completed.

PROTECTION OF STRUCTURES AND DRAINAGE

There shall be no interference with structures on, over or under the highway. Interference with drainage installations must be avoided. The existing cross section and drainage of the highway shall not be disturbed. The longitudinal flow of water along the gutter line must not be interrupted. It shall be the responsibility of the owner to make adequate provision for all transverse, lateral and longitudinal drainage affected by his construction.

MATERIALS AND WORKMANSHIP

Materials and workmanship used in construction affecting Highway property shall be in accordance with the Department's Standard Specifications and are subject to inspection and approval of the Department of Transportation. Where conditions warrant, the Department may assign an inspector to the project at the expense of the permittee. The Department shall reserve the right to demand from the applicant as a condition of any permit, a bond or certified check in an amount sufficient to guarantee or insure the proper maintenance or restoration of the area disturbed.

ADVERTISING STRUCTURES

Signs or structures shall not be erected on or overhanging any portion of the Department of Transportation Right-of-Way.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

This permit is subject to all local municipal ordinances, rules and regulations. The Department reserves the right to impose special conditions in special cases.
