6:30 P.M. (PREVAILING TIME) TWP. COMMITTEE WORKSESSION MEETING

Mayor Matalucci opened the meeting in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act requirements.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS AND PROJECT UPDATES:

Administration & Finance:

The Clerk discussed Assembly Resolutions No. 78 – Urging Counties and Municipalities to Create 2020 Census Complete Count Committees and No. 79 – Designating March 12 – 20 of 2020 as “Get Out the Count Week” to encourage full Census count of New Jersey’s population with the Township Committee. She advised that the Township participates in the County’s 2020 Census Complete Count Committee and that we have posters displayed as well as information available at the department windows and posted on the website. The Committee indicated that in light of our current level of participation, it was not necessary at this time to create our individual committee.

The Clerk shared that the Administrator has scheduled a Shred Event for Saturday, May 16th from 9 am to noon in the parking lot of the Municipal Building, located at 571 Petersburg Road, Dennisville.

Engineering:

The Engineer discussed the proposed Recreation Project at Sunks Creek off of Sea Isle Blvd. He advised the Committee that upon further research, the area is not under the jurisdiction of the Township, it is the County. The Engineer and Committee continued to discuss the project, and questioned whether the County is eligible for Open Space Grants and a possible Shared Services with Sea Isle if we decide to move forward with the application for this project.

The Engineer reviewed a narrative for the County Bikeway Ground Breaking Ceremony.
