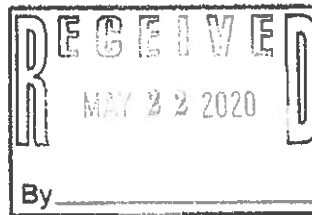

I CONTINUE TO INSPECT THE SITE WORK OF THE B&R LAND LLC. PROJECT AT ROUTE 9 AND EAST RISING SUN DRIVE AND THE SITE WORK FOR THE WALTER BROS. PROJECT ON ROUTE 83 IN SOUTH DENNIS.

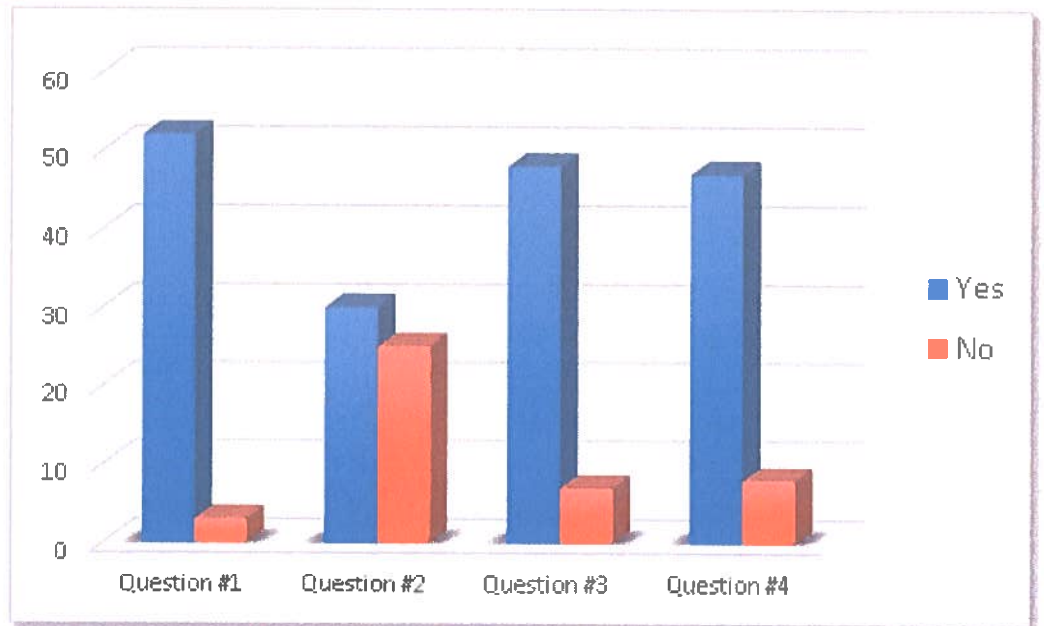
