WHEREAS, the position of Natural Resource Agent (ANRA) of Rutgers Cooperative Extension of Cape May County was vacated in or about April of 2019; and

WHEREAS, shortly thereafter, the University of Rutgers and the Cooperative Extension of Cape May County placed all in person interviews and hiring for all positions on hold due to the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, over the last few months, the University of Rutgers has made exceptions to the hiring freeze when necessary; and

WHEREAS, at this juncture, the Cape May County Board of Agriculture feels there is a crucial need to fill the position of ANRA; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee is of the opinion that as tourism embraces agriculture, there is a need for primary leadership to guide farmers in the development and implementation of this market providing a benefit to everyone within Cape May County; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee also acknowledges the need for economic development within the agriculture and natural resources sectors of Cape May County; and

WHEREAS, when the ANRA was originally hired, Cape May County funded 25% of the salary. By the time the position was vacated the percentage funded by Cape May County was less than 21% of the salary; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby urges the Cape May County Board of Commissioners to support the hiring of an Agriculture and Natural Resources Agent by increasing its funding for the position; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis, Cape May County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The allegations of the preamble are incorporated herein by this reference.
- 2. The Township Committee strongly urges the Cape May County Board of Commissioners to support the hiring of an Agriculture and Natural Resources Agent for Cape May County.

# ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK

(N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 1% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis in the County of Cape May finds it advisable and necessary to increase its SFY 2021 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that a 3.5 % increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$98,509.48 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Dennis, in the County of Cape May, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the SFY 2021 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Dennis shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5 %, amounting to \$137,913.27, and that the SFY 2021 municipal budget for the Township of Dennis be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

Below I have listed the status of engineering related projects for Committee's information:

# 1. NJDOT Trust Fund Applications for FY 2020 & 2021

An application for the reconstruction of Chestnut Street and East Avenue was submitted to the NJDOT under the local aid trust fund program for FY 2020 and 2021. The NJDOT awarded Dennis Township \$185,000.00 (FY 2020) and \$135,000.00 (FY 2021) for the reconstruction of Chestnut Street and East Avenue (\$320,000.00 total). A proposal for land surveying and engineering services has been submitted to Committee for review and approval.

# 2. 2021 Capital Roadway Improvements

Dennis Township as identified the following roadways to be include in the 2021 roadway improvement project:

- Savage Bridge Road (Sunset Road to Last Driveway) Roadway Improvements
- Sunny Lane (Dennisville Road to Shady Lane) Roadway Improvements
- Hagan Road Drainage Improvements
- Macellaro Road (Hoffman Mill Road to Hands Mill Road) Roadway Improvements
